After yet another successful season, we will again feature 5 concerts! We have a wonderful line-up of artists and beautiful chamber music works.

- (October 24) We had so much fun with the Borodin quintet last April that we decided to start of the season with two spectacular works for the same combination: The great Schubert quintet and the lesser known, Russian composer, Sergei Taneyev. Featuring the Amernet quartet, joined by cellist, Iris van Eck.
- (November 28) After a wonderful performance of the Rachmaninoff trio last season, violinist Dmitri Pogorelov together with the van Eck /Gekic duo will return to perform Mozart, Ravel and Dvorak piano trios
- (February 6) Violinist Misha Vitenson , violist Michael Klotz and cellist Iris van Eck team up for a concert of string trio's. This time we will perform Beethoven's Serenade for string trio as well as works by Francais and others
- (March 20) A cello piano recital with the van Eck / Gekic duo. We will finish our journey through all the Beethoven Sonatas with opus 5, no 2. Works by Bridge, Dohnányi and Villa Lobos will also be on the program
- (April 17) The last concert of Chameleon's 9th season will feature tenor Eduardo Aladrén as well as our own Misha Dacic on piano and Iris van Eck on cello.
